LETTER OF UNDERSTANDING

between

WILFRID LAURIER UNIVERSITY

and the

WILFRID LAURIER UNIVERSITY FACULTY ASSOCIATION

Re: Article 11.2.5

Whereas the article 11.2.5(f)(viii) of the Collective Agreement for WLUFA Full-time Faculty and Professional Librarians (2011-2014) requires one (1) Teacher Education Candidate on the Search Committee for the Dean of the Faculty of Education; and

Whereas the review of (or search for) the Dean of the Faculty Education commences early in the Fall term when the Teacher Education Candidates are new to the program;

The Parties agree to amend 11.2.5(f)(viii) to require either one Teacher Education Candidate or one Teacher Education Candidate who graduated from the Faculty of Education in the previous academic year.

Amended language:

(viii) Dean of the Faculty of Education:

The Search Committee for the Dean of the Faculty of Education shall be composed of the following 12 voting members:

- The Vice-President: Academic who shall chair the committee;
- 1 external member of the Board of Governors;
- 1 Dean from another academic unit;
- 1 Teacher Education Candidate in the Faculty of Education or a Teacher Education Graduate who completed the Bachelor of Education program in the Faculty of Education in the previous academic year;
- 1 staff member:
- 2 tenured faculty members or Members holding Provisional or Candidacy Appointments elected from and by the full-time faculty of the Faculty of Education;

- 3 tenured faculty members from outside the Faculty of Education elected by the University Faculty Council. Among these, there shall be no more than one Member from each of the Faculties of Arts, Science, Social Work and Music and the School of Business and Economics and Laurier Brantford. Cross-appointed members of the Faculty of Education are eligible. Of these tenured faculty Members, at least one shall hold an Ontario Teaching Certificate, or other equivalent professional designation;
- 2 Senate Members elected by Senate.
