**Re:** **2015–2016 University and College Financial Reports Now Available On-line**

Since 1999, CAUT has distributed to our local associations annual financial reports for Canadian universities and degree-granting colleges. The 2015–2016 reports are now available for viewing and download. The reports are derived from data provided by Statistics Canada and the Canadian Association of University Business Officers (CAUBO).

The online Post-Secondary Institutions Financial Reporting System enables CAUT member associations to download the report for their own institution, as well as any other institution reporting to CAUBO. The reports also include provincial totals and reports by university classification.

To access the Post-Secondary Institutions Financial Reporting System, you will need to login to the "Members Only" section of the CAUT website. Under "Members Only" in the left column, select "Collective Bargaining" then under the "Resources" subheading, select "Post-Secondary Institutions Financial Reports" and follow the on-line instructions.

<http://www.caution.ca/members-only/collective-bargaining>. You have the option to select "Standard Annual Report" or "Longitudinal Revenues and Expenditures". Reports are available from 1971–72 to 2015–2016.

The Post-Secondary Institutions Financial Reporting System is a valuable source of information for financial data and allows for comparison between institutions. It is not a substitute for annual audited institutional financial statements. Please consult the audited financial statements from your individual institutions.
