1.00 PURPOSE

1.01 The purpose of this policy is to provide guidance on WLUFA's practice of recognizing Members' life events.

2.00 DEFINITIONS

2.01 Member refers to any Member of either Bargaining Unit.

- 2.02 Life Events
 - **a.** Where a Member, or the spouse or partner of a Member, has given birth or adopted a child or children;
 - b. Where a Member is on sick leave because of a serious illness or accident;
 - c. Where a Member or retired Member has died;
 - **d.** Where a Member experiences bereavement due to the death of a child, spouse, partner or any relative of the Member who resides permanently with the Member.

3.00 POLICY

3.01 In the event that a Member experiences a life event as defined in 2.02, the Executive is authorized to send a gift, gift card or flowers, or send the equivalent sum to the charity selected by the family in lieu.

3.02 The value of each gift, gift card, order of flowers, or charitable donation will be a minimum of \$75 but will not normally exceed \$100.
