Already a member of the Century Club (would have happened sooner if seniority points had been counted during her first decade at Laurier!), Elin intends to not only continue her teaching but also her communications work on behalf of CF in the upcoming round of negotiations.

Beyond the classroom, Elin's work and influence has been felt in the WLU Press (during which time she produced the WLUSA Daily during 2001-2002 strike), Languages and Literature, and the Office of Research (from which she retired in 2019). It was her 'bi-union' status (member of both WLUSA and WLUFA) that allowed her to foster meaningful collaborations and support networks, expanding her impact within the Laurier community. On many occasions she called for and garner support for CF efforts at the table and on the street from WLUSA. Elin's involvement in both WLUSA and WLUFA underscore her dedication to collective action and solidarity.

Elin's over four decades of CF experience has provided her with a comprehensive understanding of CF challenges. This, coupled with her ability to communicate (both in the classroom and professionally, outside her teaching), and commitment to enhancing the welfare of CF, is why her decades of contributions to WLUFA's communications has been so valued. In addition to Elin's contributions to the Advocate over the years, she was a central member of the most recent Action Committee, was an important contributor to the 2016 Action Committee, and played a pivotal communications role during the CF strike in 2007. Her steadfast support during negotiations underscores her unwavering dedication to advocating for the rights of Contract Faculty.
